- A. Structured abstracts in English, limited to 300 words (excluding title and authors' details)
- B. The Screening Committee will scrutinize the submitted abstracts for the relevance and methodological soundness.
- C. The decision of the screening committee regarding acceptance of the abstract as oral / poster presentation is final.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER

- A. All posters should be prepared in English and must be self explanatory.
- B. Poster should be anonymized (do not reveal the identity of the institution in the poster), and should include abstract number in the title (will be informed to the presenters by the organizers)
- C. Layout: Portrait
- D. Size of poster: 100 cm x100 cm
